Future industrial impacts were generated by identifying the Cultural Resources that had their centroid located in either a wind target area, solar target area or within the mineral belt.

Wind target areas and solar PV target areas were created by the Clear Creek County Mapping Department. The criteria for each is as follows:

Wind Target Areas: Excludes areas of slope greater than 30°, U.S.F.S. designated roadless areas, wilderness areas (1B, 1B-1), wind classes 1,2,3,4, and areas beyond 1 mile of County maintained roads.

Solar PV Areas: Excludes areas of slope greater than 30°, aspects not facing South, South East, South West, U.S.F.S. designated roadless areas, wilderness areas, and areas beyond 1 mile of County maintained roads.
